Since 1920 the League of Women Voters has worked at national, state and local levels to educate citizens about good government and to advocate for public policy positions we support. By joining LWV, you become part of one of the most respected groups directly involved in making democracy work for *all* citizens.

The priorities of the Metro Phoenix League will vary from year to year as the needs and interests of our community and the focus of our elected representatives change. We choose issues to study based on consensus and may take positions on these issues, although we never support or oppose political parties or candidates for office. Topics of interest to our League over the last year have included birthright citizenship, redistricting, corporations as persons, federal government involvement in education, and health care reform.

Members of LWV Metro Phoenix have many opportunities to make our community stronger. Members stay informed and are called to action via many different avenues: regularly scheduled team meetings held at 3 different Valley locations, our general meetings for all Metro members, and a monthly newsletter known as the C&C (Calendar and Comments), as well as state League messages and action alerts.
